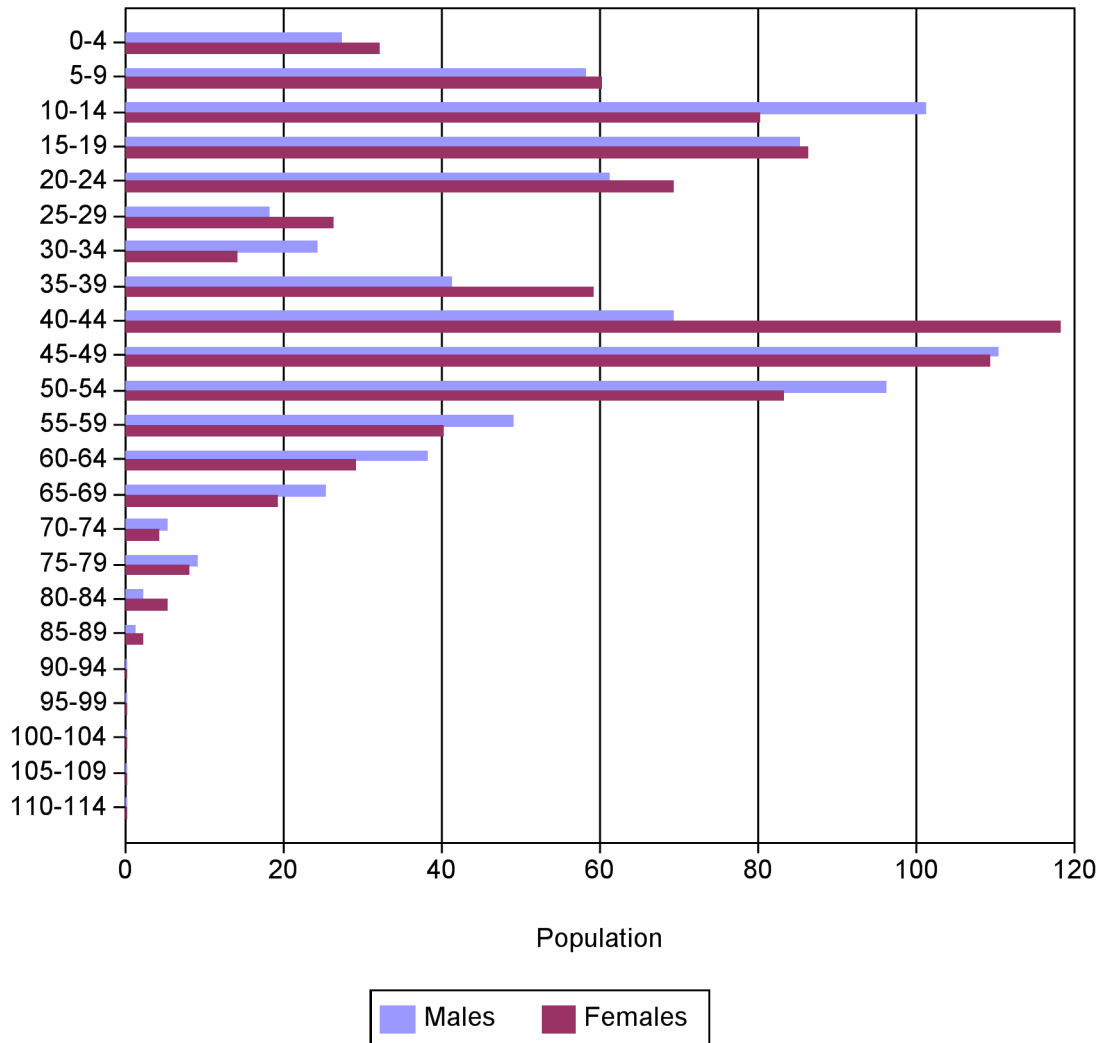

Population by Age and Gender



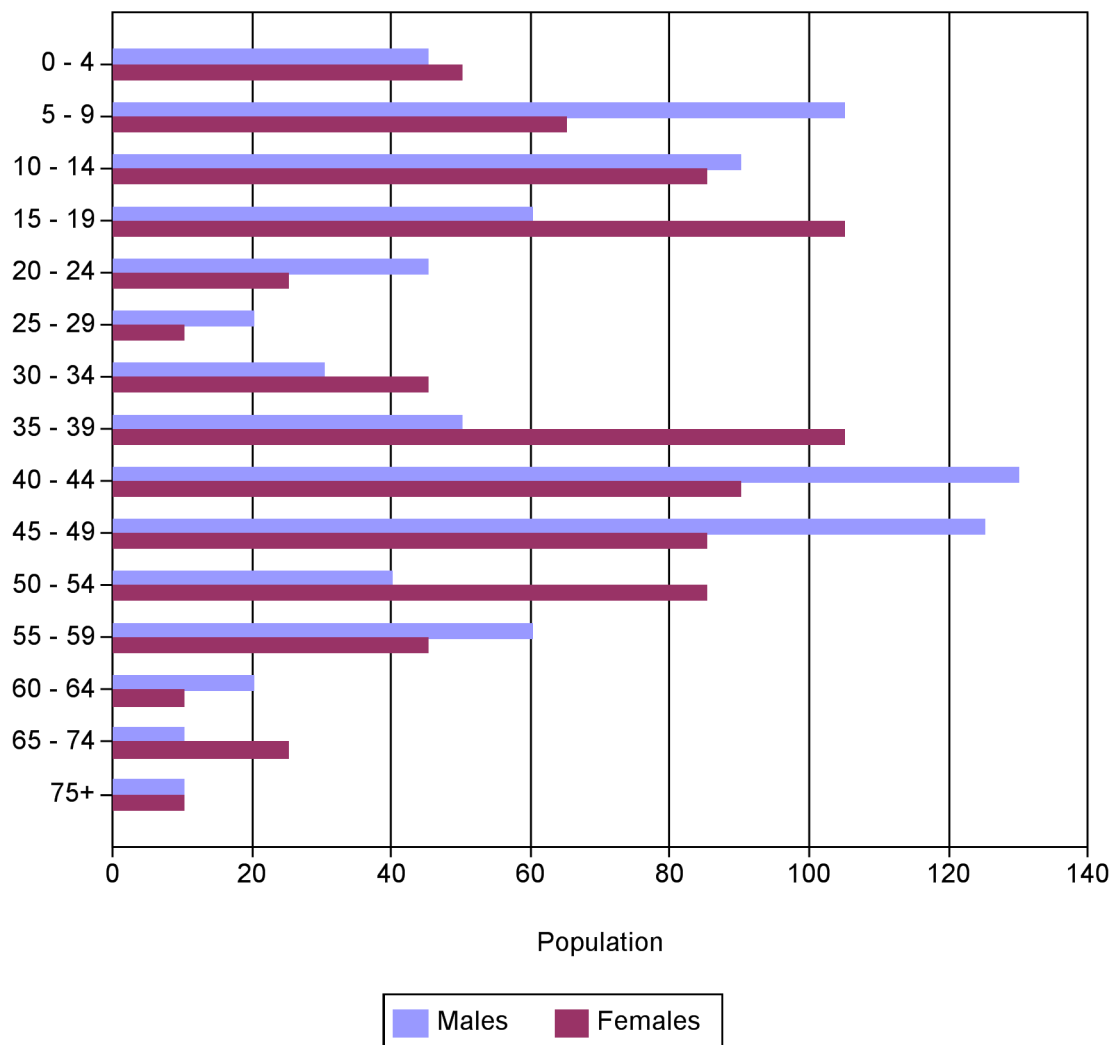

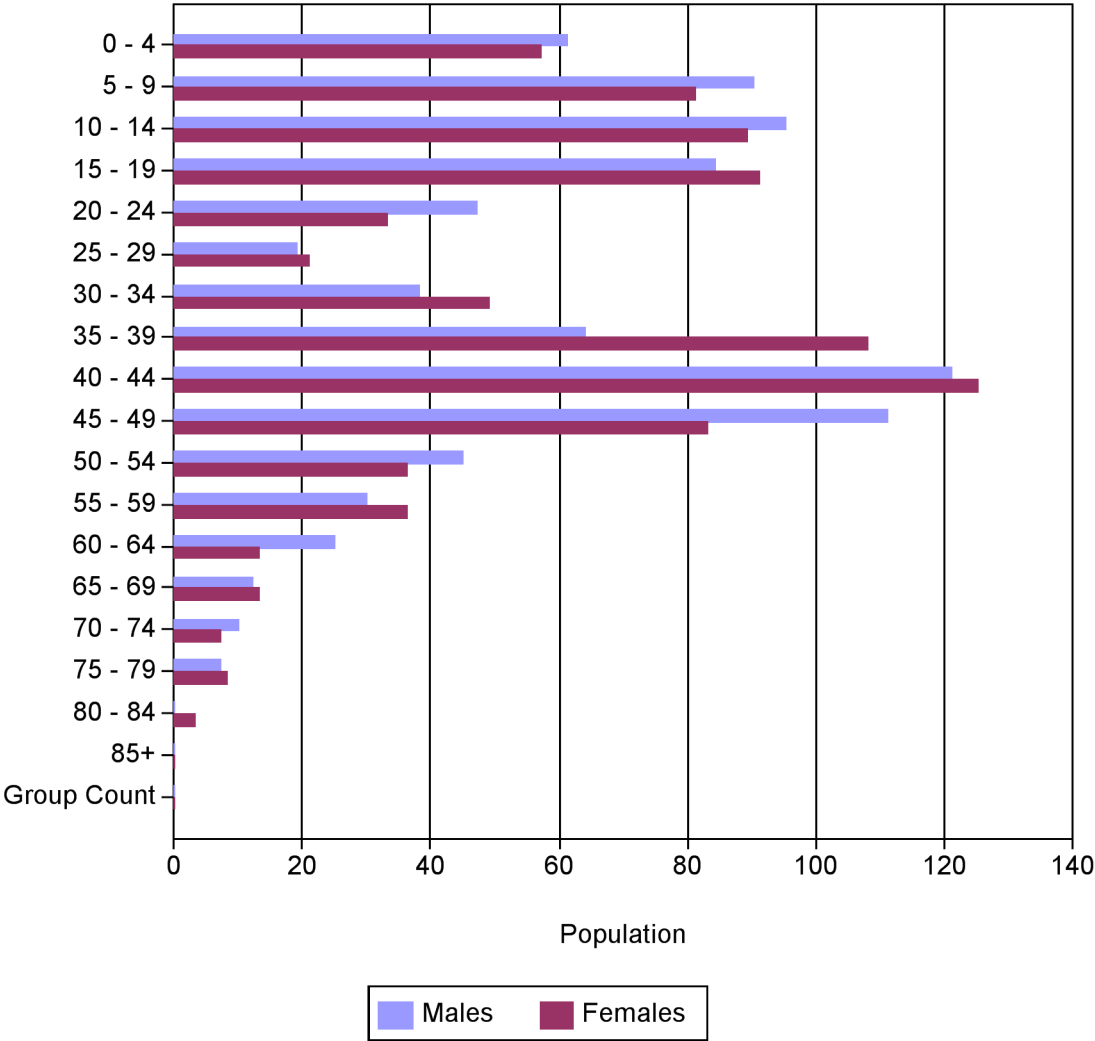

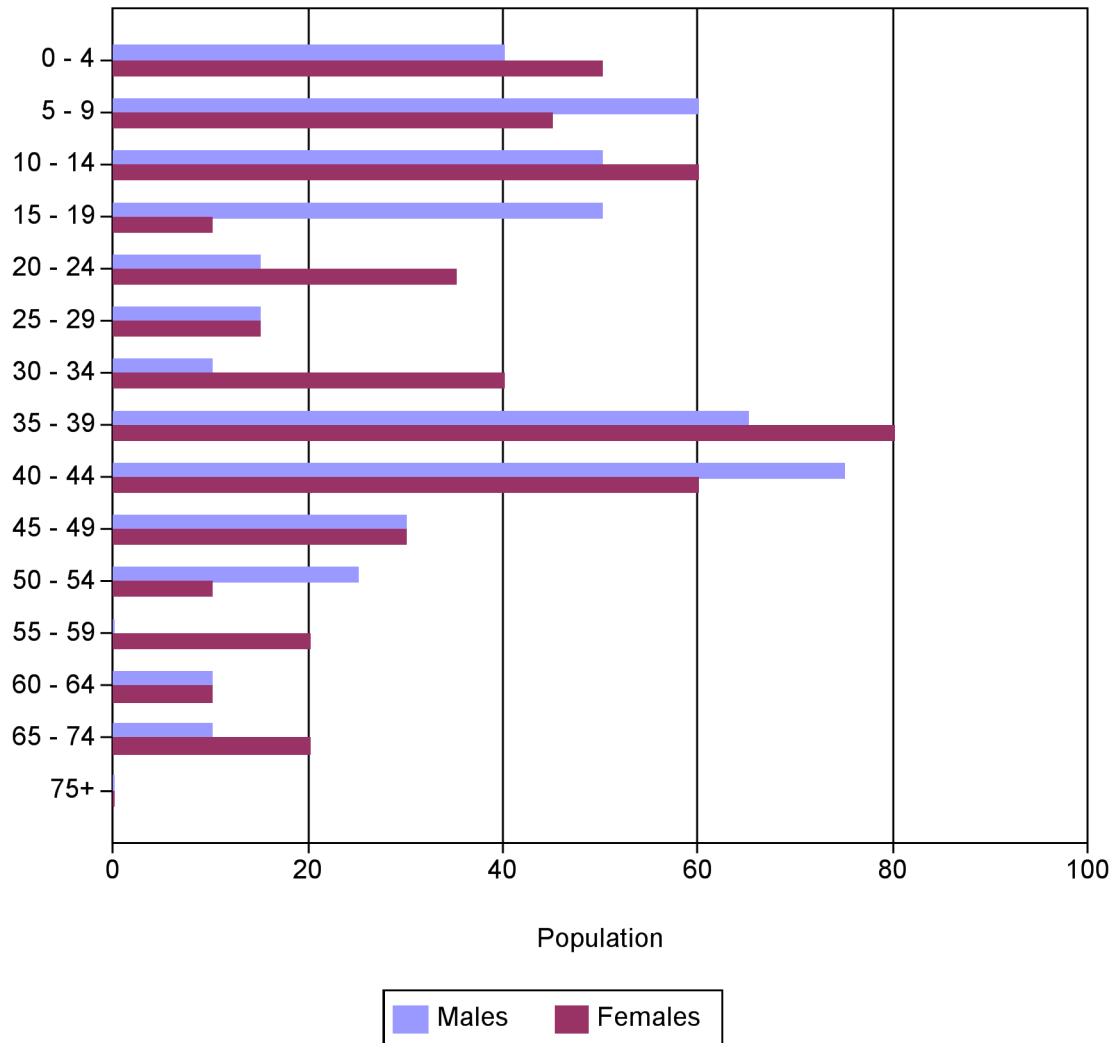

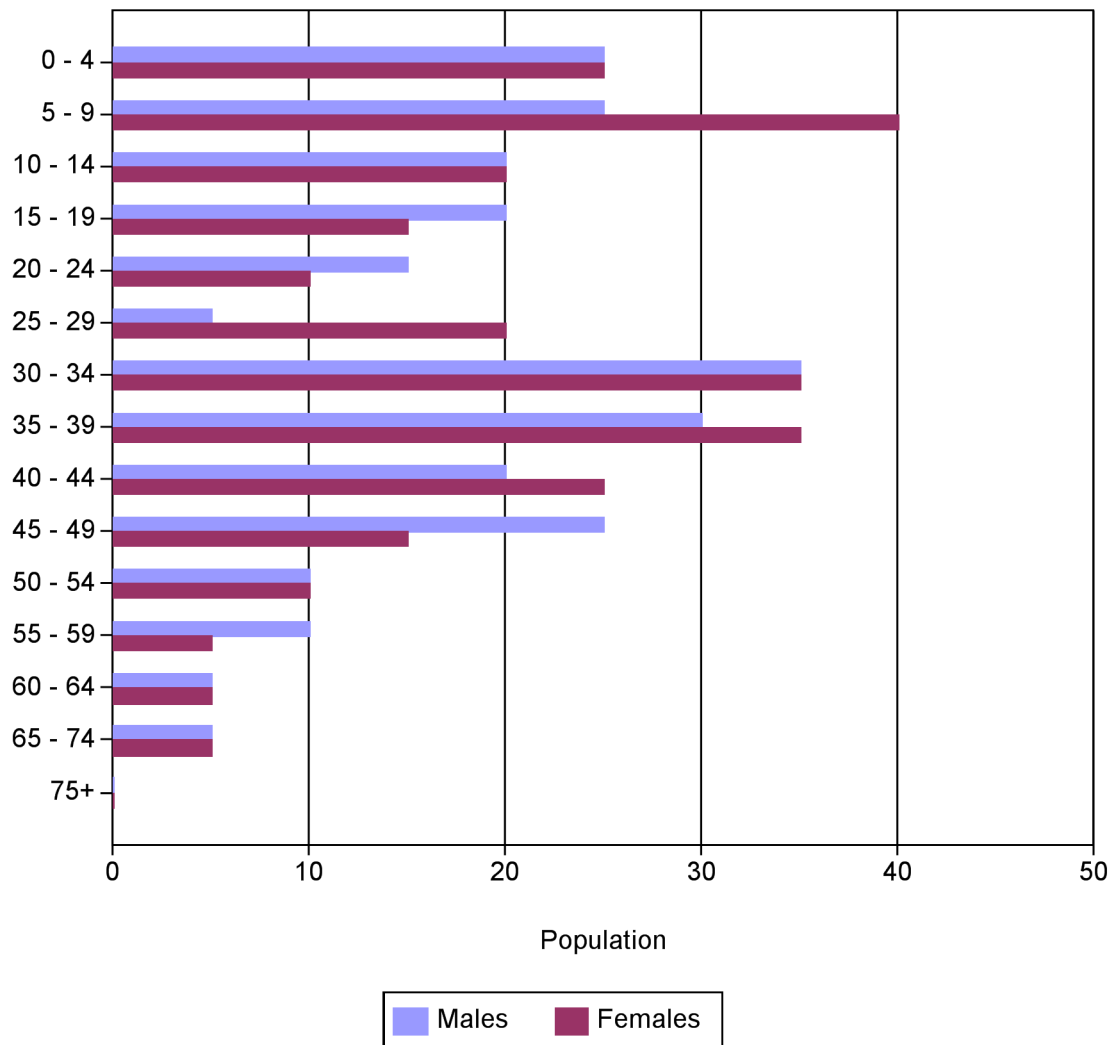
